If you could lend a marquee or are first-aid qualified or would just like more information please call Nicky 01708 760902

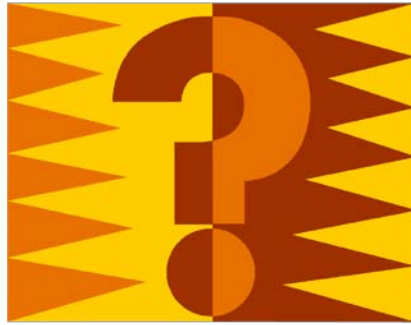
FIRST AID COURSE
